ARTICLE IX. OFFICERS

Section 1. Officers

- a. The elected officers for the branch shall be President and Financial Vice President.
- b. The President shall be elected in even years. The Financial Vice President shall be elected in odd years.

Elected and appointed officers shall serve for a term of two years.

ARTICLE VIII. NOMINATIONS AND ELECTIONS Section 1. Nominations

a. There shall be a nominating committee of three members, elected or appointed as follows: one current officer and two branch members in good standing.

Think about serving as President as well. I am in my second term as President and will term out next year. We MUST have a President and a Finance Officer to continue as an AAUW branch. Someone can serve with me in 25-26 and learn the duties of the position, then take over as President in 26-28.
